DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

The action Youth Exchange of the Erasmus Plus Program allows groups of young people from different countries to meet and live together and carry out a work program on a chosen topic.

Alonte is a small town in Veneto, Italy. In collaboration with a team of local young people, the municipality would like to promote an itinerant and active experience through different kind of multidisciplinary activities in order to investigate new ways of promoting of its territory area among young people, especially through the exploitation of natural resources, historical locations and local traditions.

OBJECTIVES

The project aims to develop a melting pot of experiences between foreign and local people that will create a path of awareness about how to involve young people in the promotion and development of their cities\towns\villages using art as a tool of participation.

During the youth Exchange, participants will carry out a work program designed and prepared by them before the project, among the topic “*Peculiarities of Rural Areas*”

The final achievement of the project is to create some interesting items (graffiti, land art elaborates, etc...) in the town and its surrounding.

Some examples of activities that can be part of the project are:

- Visits and excursions;
- Investigating the connection between creativity and territory area (through non formal activities)
- Meeting with experts to discover natural resources and natural phenomena of the territory;
- Experimenting varying form of art artistic discipline (painting, sculpture, etc...)
- Preparing art elaborates
